The seminar titled "Yes, We Can End TB" was conducted on 24th March 2023. The event aimed to raise awareness about tuberculosis (TB) and discuss strategies to combat this global health issue. The keynote speaker for the seminar was Mr. K. Ranjith Kumar, a renowned expert in the Clinical trials. The event was held in the college premises and was attended by over a large number of students. KEY POINTS DISCUSSED:

Mr. K. Ranjith Kumar, delivered a comprehensive overview of tuberculosis, its impact on global health, and the challenges associated with its eradication. He emphasized the need for a multi-pronged approach involving governments, healthcare systems, and communities to effectively combat TB.

- 1. Global TB burden: Mr. K. Ranjith Kumar presented statistical data highlighting the magnitude of the TB problem worldwide. He discussed the prevalence of TB in different regions, its impact on vulnerable populations, and the economic burden it imposes on societies.
- **2. Challenges in TB control:** The resource person outlined the major challenges in tackling TB, including limited access to quality healthcare, lack of awareness, inadequate funding, the emergence of drug-resistant strains, and social stigma associated with the disease.
- **3. Importance of early diagnosis:** Mr. K. Ranjith Kumar stressed the significance of early detection and prompt diagnosis in reducing TB-related morbidity and mortality. He highlighted the need for improved diagnostic techniques and increased investment in research and development.
- **4. Treatment and management:** The speaker discussed the current standard treatment protocols for TB, including the use of directly observed therapy (DOTS) and the importance of complete adherence to medication. He also highlighted the importance of patient support systems and the need for mental health support for individuals affected by TB.
- **5. Preventive strategies:** Mr. K. Ranjith Kumar emphasized the role of preventive strategies in controlling the spread of TB. He discussed the importance of vaccination, particularly the Bacillus Calmette-Guérin (BCG) vaccine, and the need for targeted interventions in high-burden areas.
- **6.
